NAMC ENTERS INTO A SEPARATION AGREEMENT WITH FORMER CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER ZAMA XALISA

This statement serves to confirm that the Board of the National Agricultural Marketing Council (NAMC) has entered into an amicable separation agreement with its former Chief Executive Officer (CEO) Mr. Zama Xalisa effective on 3 February 2020. This follows an investigation into alleged misconduct and a disciplinary process initiated against him between October 2019 and February 2020.

The Council will now commence with a formal process of recruiting a CEO in order to ensure that the NAMC continues to focus on its core mandate of delivering strategic marketing advice and services to the Minister and directly affected groups in the agricultural sector.
